



TO PREPARE FOR EXPORT TO KML:

- 1) Create a (short integer) column in the Attribute table called "KML strike"
- 2) Sort the table smallest to largest using the right-hand rule strike field
- 3) Select by attribute all strike records from 0 to 90;
- 4) Use the field calculator in the "KML strike" field to fill values by adding 90 to strike;
- 5) Select by attribute the remaining strikes;
- 6) Use the field calculator to populate the KML strike field for these records by subtracting 270 from strike

ALTERNATIVELY

- 1) Create a lookup table with two columns, one for RHR strike and another for KML strike
- 2) Join the lookup table to the strike and dip table, using RHR strikes as the common key

BEFORE EXPORTING TO KML:

1) In the symbology tab, set the strike and dip symbol rotation to the KML strike field and use the "Geographic" reference frame.
